To whom it may concern,

The Directorate General for Climate Action of the European Commission has contracted a consortium led by Öko-Recherche GmbH and including RE-xpertise (Karsten Burges) and Öko-Institut Consult GmbH to support the implementation and review of EU F-gas and ozone policies through reports and analysis on specific areas or sectors covered by the F-gas Regulation, the Ozone Regulation and the Montreal Protocol.
